TUITION

Your tuition investment of **\$700** covers all program costs, including meals, orientation retreat, kick off mixer & graduation. Tuition may be paid by the participant or by their employer or local sponsor. If accepted into the LLV program, you and/or your employer/sponsor will be billed for the tuition fee.

A limited number of partial scholarships are available to those participants needing financial assistance.

Year Two Mentorship
